The new non-profit raises funds solely to provide scholarships for kids who have multiple sclerosis (MS) or a parent with MS

It is one of the few programs created just for children who have a parent with MS, or have themselves been diagnosed with the incurable disease. Each available \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded based on the applicant's academic performance, community involvement, and personal experience with MS.

The PreJax Foundation actively seeks and relies upon donations from corporate donors, friends and family, and individuals across the globe whose lives have somehow been affected by MS. As the organization awaits 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status from the IRS, it is enthusiastically launching a GoFundMe campaign (www.GoFundMe.com/PreJaxFoundation) to help raise money for additional scholarships to be awarded in the spring of 2016.

“As a mother with MS who has two very active boys, this cause is very personal to me,” said Foundation President and founder Sylvia Longmire. “These kids are truly special, having to learn patience and understanding and helpfulness at a much younger age than most. It can be a real struggle for a parent with MS to pay for college when treatments and doctor visits swallow up so much money. Our goal is to make life easier for these kids of MS, as well as for their families.”
